10. Note the number of the bus and the driver's name if more than one bus is used.

11. Drop-off points for all returning buses are the same as pick-up locations.

12. No smoking permitted on the bus.

13. If fewer than 30 persons sign up for a tour, the tour may be cancelled.

14. When two buses are used and you wish to sit with a friend, you should both board at the same location if possible.

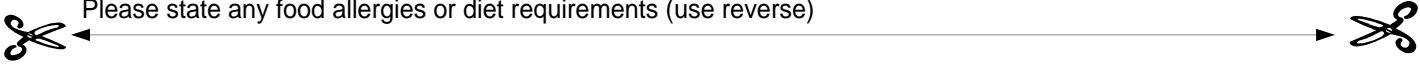
